**SUMMER DINING PLAN
Terms and Conditions – Summer 2009**

Dining Plan Enrollment

- The Summer Dining Plan is a sales-tax free, pre-paid declining balance account, valid for the period June 1, 2009 through August 21, 2009
- Points may be used to purchase food items in cash at la carte locations at full value, or meals at our designated All You Care to Eat dining halls at a discounted price. In addition, bulk food items and toiletries can be purchased in the convenience shops
- A nonrefundable \$25 application fee is charged on each plan
- The dining plan card is your campus issued ID card, and therefore nontransferable
- The plan is nonrefundable and account balances cannot be applied to/from other semesters or to/from other accounts

Dining Plan Program

- Opening and Closing Dates – points will be available for use from June 1, 2009 to August 21, 2009
- Hours of Operation – Dining Services reserves the right to modify dining hours of operation as demand dictates
- Acceptance Locations – points will be accepted at all food locations and convenience shops on campus
- Payment – you are required to pay for the dining plan for which you are enrolled. Payment may be made by check (payable to the University of Maryland), major credit card or cash
- Enrollment Location – plans can be purchased in the Contract Office at 1109 South Campus Dining Hall, from 8:30AM to 4:30PM, Monday through Friday
- Use of Identification Card – your dining plan card is your campus issued ID card. Your plan is declining balance and the amount of each purchase will be deducted by swiping your ID card at the point of purchase.
- Lost Cards – if your card is lost or stolen you must deactivate it by using Dining Services On-Line Services at www.dining.umd.edu. Dining Services is not responsible for purchases made while the card is still in use.
- Replacement cards can be obtained at Records and Registration in the Mitchell Building
- Contract Termination – Your contract may be terminated due to violation of these terms and conditions or disciplinary action by the campus in accordance with the campus Code of Student Conduct. You will receive no refund for any charges that have been paid.

Conditions of Dining Plan Participation

- Serving Policy – (1) Dining halls – the dining plan when used in The Diner or South Campus Dining Hall features unlimited servings of all meals eaten in these locations. Food is intended to be consumed on the premises. You cannot take food out of the dining halls except for beverage or take with items like a cookie or ice cream.
- (2) Cash at la carte locations – the dining plan will operate as a declining balance account and you will pay only for items selected. These locations can be used for carry out items.
- Alcoholic beverages cannot be obtained with any dining plan card

Dining Plan Options

- Summer Dining Plans are available at three levels and each includes a \$25 application fee.
- | Level | Price | Points | Fee |
|---------|-------|--------|------|
| Level 1 | \$175 | \$150 | \$25 |
| Level 2 | \$325 | \$300 | \$25 |
| Level 3 | \$625 | \$600 | \$25 |
- The plan can be used to purchase meals at our designated All You Care to Eat locations, food items in our cash at la carte locations, and bulk items or toiletries in our Convenience Shops
 - Note – purchases made with the Summer Dining Plan are exempt from state sales tax. It is to your advantage to purchase an adequate account level, as purchases made with cash or credit card will be charged 6% sales tax.

By using your dining plan card and participating in the program, you agree to accept all of the terms, conditions and restrictions of this contract and any revisions to it, which may occur periodically.
