Criteria:

1. Superior attendance

3. Exemplary customer service
4. Positive, cheerful interaction with both supervisors and co-workers
5. Demonstrating a commitment to cooperation on the job
6. Consistently displaying an upbeat attitude while working
7. Superior job performance and skill in assigned work area

Each unit is permitted to nominate one student employee. Please send top sheet with the following information on it:

1. Name of student
2. Campus address
3. Name of unit
4. Telephone number
5. Grade point average
6. Number of years employed by Dining Services

On a second sheet, please write in 150 words or less your reason for nominating this individual using the criteria from above (#1-7).

All the information should be sent to Sister Maureen, IHM by Friday, February 25, 2011. No nominations will be accepted after 3:30 PM.

As you are aware, time is of the essence, so your quick response would be greatly appreciated. A committee will review the nominations and send the top three individuals to Colleen Wright-Riva. The senior staff will then conduct interviews to determine the Emma Powers Award recipient and runners-up.
